Notes:

1. Each dojo is responsible of providing all the protection items to the own team.
2. It is not allowed to bandage the fist in the first round, and only with the doctor approval starting with the second round.
3. The referees and judges decisions are not to be challenged. IKO KYOKUSHINKAIKAN Kancho, Yoshikazu OYAMA and Romanian Branch Chief, Shihan Horatiu Adrian NEAGOIE and Swiss Branch Chief, Shihan Peter von Rotz, represent the supreme authority upon the entire tournament, being supported by Sensei Nicolai TUDOR and Sensei Ovidiu BASTEIA in this matter, as mats supervisors.
4. Do not forget to register all the competitors, including their weight.

4.2 Technical Aspects: The official technical meeting will be held an evening before tournament, along with conducting the last referees' preparation for tournament and setting up the order of participation and the allignment to Honbu Kata (specific discussions will take place daily).

Kata Assessment: will be done by a 5-referee team (1 x central and 4 x corner)

- First Round will be assessed from 6.00 to 7.00
- Second Round will be assessed from 7.00 to 8.00
- Third Round will be assessed from 8.00 to 9.00

Kata Performance:

The participants will act as follows:

1. On hearing his/her name (by official speaker announcement), the participant will appear at the front line of tatami (opposite side of the central referee), salutes „Osu” and wait for the command „NAKKAI” in order to step in the tatami;

2. On the command of the central referee – „NAKKAI” – the participant will step in the tatami up to the drawn line inside tatami, says „Osu” and waits for the next command of the central referee;

3. The central referee will command the kata (for the first round) and the participant will repeat the name of the kata, therefore the central referee will be sure the participant understood the requirements;

NOTE: in the third round, after the competitor entered the tatami, the central referee will raise up his right hand and this will be signal to the participant to say the name of the desired/chosen kata), to move into MUSUBI DACHI – MOKUSO, to open eyes and get into UCHI HACHIJI DACHI+FUDO DACHI with IBUKI and then to start performing kata.

4. The central referee will command directly „YOI” for all Taikyokus (and „MUSUBI DACHI-MOKUSO” for al the Pinans, Intermediate Katas and Superior Katas). The participant will perform the required specific gestures.

5. After the participant's required performance, the central referee will command directly „HAGIME” and the participant will start to execute/perform kata in his/her/their way, while the whole referee team is observing/watching/assessing the kata performance.

6. When kata performance is finished, the central referee will command, one by one, „NAORE, YASME”, and the participant will perform the required specific gestures, one by one, waiting for the referees' assessments in FUDO DACHI, facing the central referee.

7. The central referee will command „HANTEI” and the corner referees will prepare their digits assessment, keeping their heads down, watching „just for themselves”, without being influenced by the other team referee members.

8. The central referee will command „HANTEI – TORIMASU, HANTEI” immediately using the whistle, and the corner referees will raise up their digits assessment boards facing the official table, still keeping their heads down for 5 seconds, watching „just for themselves”, without being influenced by the other team referee members.

9. The official table speaker will announce/speak up the digits assessments, starting with the central referee and continuoung with the other 4 corner referees in the clock way.

10. When the last referee's assessment is announced, the central referee will use the whistle and the other 4 corner referees will put down their digits boards.


11. The central referee will command „JOGAI” along with the specific gesture and the participant will say „Osu”, step out the tatami's boundary, backwards, without turning his back to the official table and central referee. When reaching out a few centimeters the tatami's boundary, the participant will say „Osu” for the last time, turn right and leave the area for the next participant.

KATA SPECIAL ISSUES:

1. There will be 5 announced assessments (one for each referee). The final result will consist of the sum of the 3 middle assessments, while the lowest and the highest assessments will be cut off.

2. After the first round, only the first 8 results will be qualified in the second round.

3. After the second round, only the first 8 results will be qualified in the third round (seniors).

4. If the participant(s) will apply big mistakes during performance, by modifying kata, performing  kata than the announced one, or by stopping performing the entire kata, the referees will assess the performing with the lowest assessment (e.g. 7.00), and he/she will be immediately diqualified from the diagrams.

5. In case of **DRAWING**, the two participants (**AKA** and **SHIRO**) will perform the last kata again in the same time by the 2 participants, being watched/observed/assessed simoultaneously. After finishing the kata performance, the central referee will command „HANTEI” and the corner referees will prepare their flags, keeping their heads down, watching „just for themselves”, without being influenced by the other team referee members. The central referee will command „HANTEI

– TORIMASU” immediately using the whistle, and the corner referees will raise up the flag (AKA SHIRO), still keeping their heads down for 5 seconds, watching „just for themselves”, without being influenced by the other team referee members. The central referee will be the final decision maker and will point out the winner.

!!! An example of a kata performing will be demonstrated to all the participants before the competition will start and the eventual questions may be raised up !!!

KUMITE RULES: Special notes and frequent issues / questions:

- 1.Upper Body Protection (chest + abdominal areas) is fully compulsory for the kids of the ages 6-8 years old, both girls and boys.
- 2.Upper Body Protection (chest + abdominal areas) is partially compulsory for the kids of the ages 9-10, 11-16 years old, both girls and boys. However, coaches, together with the competitor, having full approval from the child’s parents, may decide not to wear Upper Body Protection. The main referee must be notified in advance, before the start of the fighting.
- 3.Chest area Protection for girls – Depending on the body development, the competitor may choose form a variety of protections types.
- 4.Shins Protections for girls seniors – are allowed.
- 5.Head Protection for 17-18 years old – is not compulsory, but allowed to be used in order to increase the youth’s protection.
- 6.Touch contact refereeing for 6-8 years old kumite divisions. Direct kicks at Gedan / Jodan level **are NOT allowed**: Mae Geri Chusoku / Kakato, Yoko Geri Sokuto, Ushiro Geri Kakato / Sokuto. The other kicks must be “touching type”.
- 7.Full contact refereeing for 9-16 years old kumite divisions. Direct kicks at Gedan / Jodan level **are NOT allowed**: Mae Geri Chusoku / Kakato, Yoko Geri Sokuto, Ushiro Geri Kakato / Sokuto. Circular kicks are allowed: Ushiro Mawashi Geri, Uchi / Soto Mawashi Geri, Mawashi Kaiten Geri, etc.
- 8.Full contact refereeing for 17-18 years old and seniors kumite divisions. Direct kicks at Gedan level **are NOT allowed**, but at Jodan level **are allowed**: Mae Geri Chusoku / Kakato, Yoko Geri Sokuto, Ushiro Geri Kakato / Sokuto. Circular kicks are allowed: Ushiro Mawashi Geri, Uchi / Soto Mawashi Geri, Mawashi Kaiten Geri, etc, in accordance with Knock Down Full Contact Kyokushin Rules.
- 9.Grabbing technique is not allowed at all.
- 10.Groin Protection is compulsory for all boys kumite divisions.

4.3.Registration & Fees: The participation list will be completed and filled in by every dojo operator/admin dojo, by division, **No Later Than: May 27, 2016**- first phase of registering/ paying fees, **June 10, 2016** –second phase of registering / paying fees and **June 19, 2016** – third phase of registering / paying fees.
